PAIDUP TRAILS UNDER AICRP ON COTTON DURING 2015-16

All India Coordinated Research Project on Cotton is having 22 centres located in 10 states under the ages of State Agricultural Universities in all the three zones (North, Central and South) across the country. This project is associated by 99 eminent scientists cut across disciplines and effectively supported by efficient technical staff. In these centres the, AICRP trials on cotton is taken up in both the agro climatic conditions i.e Irrigated and Rainfed. The zone/location details along with rate cards for testing are given in the below table.

During the cropping season for the year 2015-16, it is proposed that under AICRP on Cotton, various products of private companies in respect of new molecules for nutrients, plant growth regulators, hormones, fertilizer, insecticides, herbicides, weedicides etc can be tested on zone basis. The testing can be got done on payment basis by all private companies. The testing will be accepted for zone-wise and cannot be taken up on location specific. It has to be done in a particular zone fully. The charges for testing the products is Rs. 20,000/- plus service tax as applicable (current rate is 12.36%) per trial per location. The rate card for testing is under for ready reference.
